- 3. Reviewed the School Site Plan/ LCAP Goals:
 - a. Technology- Rolling out 8 more Chromebook carts, (in addition to the 4 already on campus), in December 2015. This will reduce the student to device ratio, from 3:1 to 1:1.
 - b. Teacher/ Curriculum Alignment- At McManus all certified personnel will:
 - i. Move to Stage 2 or higher on the CSCS implementation plan.
 - ii. Participate in a minimum of 15 hours of PD related to CSCS.
 - iii. Meet a minimum of 10 times to analyze student achievement data.
 - c. Students- goal set to decrease high concern student lists, and increase test scores. (SBAC)
 - d. Meaningful Parent Involvement- McManus goal for 50% increase in texting and other communications between school/ teachers and families. Parent survey will be utilized to establish a baseline percent of parents who respond to communications about their students within 3 school days.
 - e. Improve School Climate- Reducing the number of chronically truant and absent students annually by 2%.
 - f. *iReady- English, Language Arts, and Math computer program; 1/16-1/17.
